## **NATOMAS JR. NIGHTHAWKS COACHES CODE OF CONDUCT**

1. I will coach with the intentions of teaching youth how to play the sports of football and/or cheerleading, not for personal gain or glory.
2. I will not be satisfied with producing a good record, but with producing good athletes.
3. I will display good sportsmanship at all times. My conduct on and off the field will be above reproach as our athletes will never rise to a standard higher than that being lived by the coach.
4. I will refrain from using profanity and making derogatory statements toward any coach, player, official, opponent, board member, or parent.
5. I will teach my athletes to prepare and compete to the best of their ability while displaying respect for coaches, teammates, officials, opponents, board members, and parents.
6. I will not smoke or use/consume drugs or alcohol while on immediately before, during, or immediately after practice, games, or any other team activities.

All Natomas Jr. Nighthawk coaches are expected to uphold the core values specified in this code of conduct. If coach misconduct is brought to the attention of Natomas Jr. Nighthawk Board of Directors the Coaches Coordinator and Athletic Director will meet with that coach to discuss the alleged misconduct. If after meeting with the coach the Coach Coordinator and Athletic Director confirm that misconduct has taken place and will assign a level of severity to the incident on a scale of 1 to 3, with 3 being the most severe.

The level of severity assigned to an incident will be based on (1) the action of the coach, (2) the context in which the incident occurred, and (3) the resulting outcome of the incident. In addition, the coach will be given a written notice and required to sign it acknowledging the incident and the level affixed to the incident.

Coaches will be marked with one point per level of severity per incident. A Level I incident will result in one point going on a coach's record, Level II will result in two points, and Level III will result in three points. A single Level III incident or four (4) cumulative points will result in an automatic one game suspension. A coach who is involved in two Level III incidents or receives seven (7) cumulative points will be suspended for the remainder of the season.
