Rules at Bear River HS

- Home teams will wear dark jerseys and visitors will wear light jerseys.
- Home teams will occupy the press box side bleachers of the stadium.
- Warm up fields are located through the far gate at the backside of the stadium. (Please do not walk teams in front of bleachers, rather use the road behind them out of respect for those that are watching the current game).
- No outside food or drinks are permitted. However team snacks are allowed.
- Only authorized participants are to be in the field area (coaches, players, cheerleaders, required SYFC badge holders, PAR, and Chain Gang volunteers).
- Parents and spectators are asked to clean up and stay in their stands. Do not hang on the yellow ropes around the field.
- No animals (except approved service animals) are allowed.

- Each team is allowed 1 ball boy and 2 water boys.
- If there are any disputes they will be handled by the presidents of the associations involved. The association involved in the game is responsible for controlling their own sideline.
- All teams shall provide PAR monitors.
- Visitors shall provide 4 adults to perform Chain Gang duties.
- Bear River HS is a smoke free zone. If you must smoke you must leave the school campus completely.
- There is zero tolerance for vulgarity and poor sportsmanship by not only the players and coaches on the field but also those in the stands.
- **Bear River Jr. Bruins reserves the right to remove anyone from the stadium that does not adhere to the above guidelines.**
